M^r Jn^o Allens marke of hoggs and Cattle viz^t two Slitts in both eares and the middle peice taken out it being formerly the marke of Henry More and Sold to John Allen wth his plantacon: Recorded the 10th of August 1671

The marke of William Lyng th^e Sonn of Fran: Ling underkeeled in the Right eare cropt and a Slitt and overkeeled in the left eare
