

Liber C James Lee Plf Tymothie Martin Def^t

The Plf arresting the Def^t in an acon of debt to the value of sixe hundred weight of toba^c preferd his declaracon

The Def^t taking advantage of th^e Plf for that his declaracon was not duelie entered three dayes before the C^{rt} as by an act of this Province is in such case provided humblie requesteth the Court that the Plfs acon may fall w^{ch} was graunted :

The Plf arresting the Defend^t in an acon of debt to th^e value of two thousand two hundred weight of toba^c prefers his Declaracon and in Confirmacon thereof the Defend^{ts} Bill.

[p. 79] Upon the producing of w^{ch} Bill the C^{rt} finds for th^e Plf the said sume of 2200th of toba^c.

Whereupon the Plf craves an allowance of his Charges w^{ch} are as followeth viz^t

p̄ Attorneys 3 dayes attendance..... 90th
 p̄ Attorneys fees..... 60

Whereupon it was ordered that the Plf pay unto th^e Defend^t the sume of 2200th of toba^c wth his Costs and Charges: upon w^{ch} ord^r a writt of execucon imediatlie issued in open C^{rt}.

John Wheeler demands an attachm^t ag^t the estate of George Bradshawe to th^e value of three thousand weight of toba^c for a servant w^{ch} the s^d Wheeler claimes of th^e said Bradshawe, he the s^d Bradshawe being now in England.

Whereupon It was ordered by the C^{rt} that an attachment should imediatelie issue forth to th^e Sherrife w^{ch} was accordingly done.

Upon an attachm^t graunted unto James Bowling bearing date th^e 24th of September 1666 It is Ordered that John Morrice pay unto the said Bowling the sume of 400th of toba^c

Dan: Makhenie having formerlie mortgaged a parcell of Land containing [*blank*] acres to Mathias Obryan upon a debt of [*blank*] of toba^c the said Mathias Obryan in open C^{rt} acknowledgeth back againe all his interest right and title to th^e said Land unto the said Daniell Makennie upon Condicon that he the s^d Makennie shall satisfie him th^e said Obryan his said debt at or before th^e [*blank*] or otherwise the said Land to returne unto the said Obryan in the same state and plight as before.

Whereas at a C^{rt} held in Charles Countie the 8th of August An^o 1665 Dan: Johnson did acknowledge a Conveyance of Land to M^r
 [p. 80] Sam: Fendall the said conveyance was this present C^{rt} confirmed unto th^e said Fendall by his wife Elizabeth Johnson
