

In a Certain Matter of difference depending in Court between Benj^a whichcott by his Attorney Matⁿ Hill plaintiff & Rob^t Cady def^t in a plea of trespas on the Case. Liber E

The Def^t having had but Short time to p^rcure his Evidence for proving how much he hath Satisfyed the p^rt craveth an imparlance w^{ch} was granted.

Thomas warner being attached to answer to Benj^a Rozer of a plea of trespas on the Case craved an imparlance which was granted by th^e Consent of the p^rt likewise.

william & Thomas Harguesse were attached to answer to Francis Kilborn & Eliz^a his wife Administratrix of the goods & Chattells of Daniel Johnson dēd of a plea that they render unto them the Sumē of two thousand pounds of tobaccoe &c.

And whereupon th^e p^rts complaine ag^t the def^{ts} for that whereas the S^d Def^{ts} by a certain writing under their hands & Seales bearing date th^e 24th day of September in the 34th year of the Dominion of Caecilius &c Annoq³ Domini 1669 became bound unto the above named Dan: Johnson to pay unto him the Sume of Two thousand pounds of tobaccoe on the 10th day of october 1671 yet the Said Def^{ts} although often thereto required the Said 2000^{lb} tobaccoe have not payd but doe altogether refuse to pay the Same whereupon the p^rts Say they are Damnfied & have Loss to the vallew of 2000^{lb} tobaccoe & thereon they bring th^r Sute

And they p^rduced this Ensueing bill.

This bill bindeth us william Harguesse & Tho: Harguesse to pay or Cause to be payd to Daniel Johnson his heires or assignes the Sumē of Two thousand pounds of tobaccoe to be payd to the Said Daniell his heires assignes or Certain attorney conveniently in Charles County on the tenth day of october to be in the yeare of our Lord 1671 To the which paym^t well & trully to be made we bind us our heires Executo^{rs} & Adm^{rs} Joyntly & Severally by these p^rnts In wittnes whereof we have hereunto Sett our hands & Seales this 24th of Septemb^r 1669

whereupon th^e Court gave Judgem^t ag^t the Def^{ts} for the Sumē of two thousand pounds of tobaccoe wth this Ensueing bill of Costs P^rferred by the p^rt:

To Atturnys Fees.....	60
To coming goeing & attendance.....	90

Likewise th^e Court gave Judgem^t ag^t the Def^{ts} for the Sumē of three thousand pounds of tobaccoe due from the Said Def^{ts} to them
