For both which Execution was issued forth ag^t th^e bodys of the def^{ts} at th^e Suite of th^e S^d p^{ts} & directed to the Sheriff

James Smallwood was Attached to answer Fra: Kilborne & Eliz^a his wife of a plea that he render unto them the Sum^e Two thousand two hundred thirty foure pounds of Tobaccoe.

Whereupon the S^d P^{ts} Complained ag^t the Said Def^t for the Said debt due to Daⁿ: Johnson de^{cd} upon a bill under his hand & Seale bearing Date the 23th day of feb^{ry} in th^e 39th yeare of the Dominion of Caecilius Annoq³ Domini 1670 & here in Court Produced, payable on the tenth day of october next Ensueing which the S^d Def^t refused to pay

whereupon the Court gave Judgement ag^t the Def^t for the Said Two thousand two hundred thirty foure pounds of Tobaccoe wth this Ensueing bill of Costs P^rferred by the p^{lt}:

Whereas the tobaccoe due from peter Long to Francis Lamb was at the Suite of Benj^a Rozer attached in the hands of the Said Peter Long, the Said peter Long came & in open Court made oath that he did Stand indebted to the Said Francis Lamb only the Sum^e of Six hundred and two pounds of Tobaccoe w^{ch} by order of Court the S^d Long is Comanded to deteyne in his hands for the use of the S^d Benj^a Rozer.

Kellam Magloghlin was attached to answer to Nichⁿ Pittoway of a plea that he render to him the Sum^e of fourteene hundred Sixty & three pounds of Tobaccoe & Caske w^{ch} he oweth & unjustly deteineth &c.

And the S^d Pittoway by his Attorney Bennett Marshiguay Complaineth agst the Said Kellam Magloghlin as Adm^r of th^e goods & Chattells of James Lindsey de^{cd} for th^e Said Sum^e due from James Lendsey by bill bearing date the 16th of May in the 38th yeare of the Dominion of Caecilius &c Annoq³ Dⁿⁱ 1670 to be paid on the tenth day of october next Ensueing &c

And the Said Kellam alleadged that in the writt to the Sheriff directed he was not nominated as Adm^r of th^e Estate of m^r James Lindsey but in his owne p^{per} name & person And further that he
