

Liber E and Eliz^a his wife Adm^{rx} of th^e goods and Chattells of Daniell Johnson deceased Defend^{ts} th^e plaintiffe declares ag^t the Defend^t p̄ his Att: Phil Symes for foure hundred pounds of tobacco, Will Britton Sworne in Court and declares th^t I knew Daniell Johnson to bargain wth Daniell Johnson for one barrell of beere for th^e w^{ch} to pay foure hundred p^{ds} of tobacco, and to his knowledge Cox was never satisfied for the Same in the life tyme of the S^d Johnson, and farther Sayes not, whereupon the Worshippfull Comishoners gave Judgm^t ag^t the Def^t wth costs of Suite

In a certaine matter of difference depending betweene Barnard Hamy Plantiff and Ann Fowke Def^t the Defendant not appeareing th^e Comish^{rs} thought fitt to referr it till the next Court

In a certaine matter of difference depending betweene Robert Cossleton plantiff and Will Gater Defendant, they both appeareing th^e Defendant craved an imparlance w^{ch} was granted

In a certaine matter of difference depending betweene Tho: Price Plantiffe and Cap^t James Neale Defendant the plaintiff p^rferrs his declaracōn: And whereupon the Said Thomas Price by Sam: Cressy his Attorney complaynes ag^t the Said Cap^t James Neale on th^e 29th day of July in th^e 40th yeare of the Dominion of Caecilius &c, over this Province of Maryland Annoq; Dñi 1672, by force of armes that is to Say wth theyre fists and wth a Stake on him the said Thomas at the house of him the said Cap^t James Neale made an assault and him beate wounded & evill intreated to the great damage and Injury of him the Said Thomas, and ag^t the peace of the said Province, whereupon he sayes he is damnefyed and hath loss to the value of 1500th of tobacco and thereupon he bringes his Suite

Gerrard Fitzgerrard Sworne in open Co^{rt} on the behalfe of the pl^t who declares th^t on the 29th of July that he was walkeing Cap^t Neales fence and that he there saw James Neale th^e Sonn of the s^d Cap^t Neale, and Thomas Price fighteing, and the said James Neale Junior called out wth a loud voyce for helpe, th^e Def^t heareing him came and wth a Stake Strucke him two or thre blowes and pushed him of from his Sonne w^h the same Stake &c

Mathew Burst Sworne in the behalfe of the Def^t and declares th^t on th^e same day Cap^t Neale and himselfe was walkeing neare th^e place where James Neale and Thomas Price was, and heareing some voyce, they went to the place and found it to be the James Neale Junior and Tho: Price, and the said Price had pulled much hayre from the head of th^e said James and farther sayes not

The Worshippfull Comishoners have ordred that a Venire facias be entred – w^{ch} is done
