That M^r Geo: Manwering of this County deceased was at his death indebted unto your Peti^oner upon accompt in the Sum^e of fifeteene hundred and Some odd pounds of tobacco w^{ch} accompt is Sett downe by the s^d Manwering under his owne hand in his booke of accompts now in the possession of the Administrat^{rs} or overseers of the said Manwerings Estate viz^t M^r Henry Adams M^r Thomas Mathewes He humbly therefore prayeth that this worshippfull Court will grant him order th^t the afores^d Admin^{rs} or Overseers pay your Peti^oner the to^b by him demanded (according to th^e accompting booke) out of the s^d Estate and as in Duty bound he shall ever pray &c.

The Certificat of M^r Henry Warren directed to th^e Comishon^{rs}

These are to certefie th^t M^r Geo: Manwering upon his death bead did acknowledge that he owed and was indebted unto Allexander Sennet his thⁿ overseer in the sum^e of fifeteene hundred Seventy Six pounds of tobacco the w^{ch} debt does allso appeare by his owne booke as this I know to be true witness my hand this 9th of March 1671/2

Whereupon th^e Worshipfull Comishoners gave him order for his tobacco.

M^r Thomas Pope appeareing in Court, Peti^oned th^e Worshipfull Comishon^{rs} th^t he giving good Security, he might possess th^e estate of Richard Smith w^{ch} estate was formerly in the possession of Francis Pope th^e Father of th^e said Thomas, whereupon th^e Comishoners granted him his request
