This Indenture made the eighth day of November Annoq³ Dñi 1672 Betweene Edmond Lyndsy of Charles County in the Province of Maryland Plant^r of the one part & Michael Minocke of the Same County & Province Plant^r of the other part, Witnesseth th^t th^e said Edmond Lyndsy for and in Considera^on of th^e quantity of three thousand five hundred pounds of tobacco & Caske to him in hand payd by th^e said Michael Minock th^e receipt whereof the said Ed-
