

Liber E Charles County ss: Fra: Kylborn and Eliza: his wife were attacht to answeare unto Sam: Cressy of a plea of trespass on the Case

And Whereupon the said Sam: Complaynes ag^t the Said Fra: and Eliza: his wife otherwise Called Eliza: Johson for th^t whereas Some tyme in June Anno Dñi 1669 or thereabouts the said Eliza: having then absented her Selfe from Dan: Johnson then her Husband and having then noe place of Residence or aboade But wandring from place to place at her Speciall Instance and request the said Sam: Cressy received harboured and entertained her in his house and there did provide her dyett and attendance dureing the tyme of her Sickness untill th^e 26th day of Septemb^r in the same Yeare to th^e Value of one thousand pounds of tobacco, Now Soe it is that the Said Fra: and Eliza: Kylborn then Called Eliza: Johnson Doth denye and utterly refuse to make any any Satisfacōn to him the Said Sam: for his trouble to the great damage and Injury of him the Said Sam: whereupon he sayes he is damified and hath lost to the Value of 1500th of to^b: and thereupon he brings his Suite

Both partyes Consenting the Worshippfull Comissioners thought fitt to putt this difference to a Jury of 12 men whose names are hereund^r written:

Which Jury brought in this ensueing Virdict That th^e Def^{ts} pay 150th of to^b for Six weekes accomodaōn:

whereupon th^e Comishioners ordred that Judgm^t Should be entred ag^t th^e Def^{ts} wth Cost of Suite

In a certaine matter of Difference depending between Benj^a Rozer Plant^f and Fra: Kylborne and Eliza: his wife Def^{ts} The Plaint^f and the Def^{ts} appeareing in Co^t, th^e Plaint^{fs} Declaraōn is read as followeth.

And whereupon th^e said Benj^a Complay^eth ag^t th^e Said Fra: and Eliza: his wife Admin^x of the goods and Chattells of Dan: Johnson deceased for th^t whereas the said Daniell Johnsō in his life tyme and at the tyme of his death Stood indebted unto him the said Benj^a for Sheriffs fees the Sum^e of one thousand eighty five pounds of to^b as by a p^ticular accōpt in Court p^duced more playnely may appeare yet the Said Fra: and Eliza: the said Sum^e of 1080th of tobacco allthough often thereunto required have not Satisfied but doeth alltogether refuse to pay the Same to the great damage and Injury
