In a difference dependinge betweene Thomas Baker Plan^{tf} & Francis Kilbourne & Elizabeth his wife Adm^{rx} of all & singular th^e goods & Chattles of Daniell Johnson, de^c, The Plaintiffe declareinge by his Attornⁿ Samuell Cressey in a plea of Trespas on the Case That at th^e request of the s^d Johnson he had paid for th^e s^d Johnson unto Amos Short the su^me of fower hundred & twenty pounds of Tobacco for goods sold by th^e s^d Short unto th^e Sd Johnson, alleadgeinge the s^d Johnson did promise & assume to repay him th^e s^d Baker at his request, But not makeinge his declara^on nor allega^on appeare to th^e Court, nor th^e Court findinge any cause of Action, The Pl^t was nonsuited and Ordered to pay Costs to th^e Defd^{ts} as followes vizt.
