[p. 134] Whereas At a Court held in Charles Countie on the 15th of Novemb^r 1665 Walter Story obteyned Judgem^t agst W^m Price & John Lambert Adm^{rs} of John Nevill deceased for the sume of thirteene hundred eighty six pounds of tobacco as by the s^d Judgem^t rela^{co}n beinge thereunto had more plainly may appeare Theis are therefore to certifie whom it may concerne That I Henry Bonner of Charles Countie Gen^l haveinge marryed Elizabeth Story the Relict & Adm^{rs} of Walter Story de^c doe acknowledge to have rec^d of Thomas Hussey who marryed the Relict of John Nevill de^c full Satisfac^{co}n for th^e s^d sume men^{co}ned in th^e Judgem^t of Court aforesaide In witnes whereof I have hereunto sett my hand this 11th day of June 1673 Henry Bonner
The above men^{co}ned rec^t was acknowledged in open Court by the s^d Henry Bonner unto th^e s^d Thomas Hussey.

In a certaine difference dependinge betweene Phillip Lynes Pl^t & Samuell Cooke Defd^t the Pl^t declares by his Attorn^r Richard Boughton & the Defd^t appeares by his Attorn^r Nicholas Best to defend the Suite vizt The Pl^t saith that on th^e 28th of May last he contracted with the Defd^t for a pipe & a hhd of Fayal wine at a certaine price betweene them (vizt) 2500th tob^s for th^e pipe & 1250th tob^s for th^e hhd & that th^e Defd^t did assigne & pfix a day for th^e deli^vy of the s^d wyne (vizt) on the 29th of the same May, And the Pl^t cominge at his prefixt day to demand the wyne the Defd^t did not deli^v but refused to deli^v the s^d wyne to th^e Plaintiffs da^mage 3000th tobacco as he saith

The Pl^t provinge by the Testimonies of W^m Boyden Jacob Peterson Hen: Appleby Tho Cooper Nich: Grosse John Kimborow & Tho: Warner the above declara^{co}n the Court ordrd a venire facias
