John Cage p^rsents a Servant named Richard Tigner & doth acknowledge he is to serve him but six yeares

Benjamin Rozer p^rsents a Serv^t named Dorothy Lybscome who is adjudged to be two & twenty yeares of age

Rob^t Robins p^rsents a Serv^t named Alice Collins who is adjudged to be One or two & twenty yeares of age

Ignatius Causine p^rsents a Serv^t named Nicholas Bayly who is adjudged to be sixteene yeares of age

Thomas Wornell p^rsents a Serv^t named [blank] on the behalfe of Thomas Harris of Pickoaxon who is adjudged to be one & twenty yeares of age

In a certaine difference dependinge betweene Alexand^r Smith Pl^t & John Allen Defd^t the Pl^t appeareinge in his p^p person & the Defd^t by Nicholas Best his Attornⁿ, The pl^t declares that he the Defd^t Sold him a man Serv^t to serve five yeares accordinge to an obligacōn hereafter men^coned, which Serv^t was by ord^r of Court sett free before he served the Pl^t fower yeares, for which he saith he is damni^fied two thousand pounds of tobacco; the Defd^t owninge his obligacōn the Court doth Order him to pay the Defd^t fifteene hundred pounds of tobacco & Costs for th^e want of Seaventeene months Service from his said Servant, the bill of Costs vizt:

To three dayes attendance at thirty p̄ day allowed 90th tobacco

[p. 136] Know all men by these p^rsents th^t I Jn^o Allen of London Merch^t doe acknowledge to have Sold unto Allexander Smith of Charles County Planter a Man Serv^t named Keodrike lloyd for th^e Terme of five Yeares w^{ch} I doe oblige my Selve to make good unto th^e s^d Smith Mortallity excepted unto w^{ch} I doe truly bind my Selve my heyres Executors & Adm^{rs} witness my hand & Seale this 28th of February 1669

In a difference dependinge betweene George Godfrey Plaint^f Adm^r of the the goods and Chattles of Stephen Mountague of this County late dec^d & Hugh French Defd^t, The Court Ordered the defd^t to pay unto the Pl^t fowerteene hundred & fifty pounds of tobacco & Costs of suite for his default of non appearance
