appears And the Defd^t by his Attornⁿ Nicholas Best appeares The Pl^t declares that at the instance & request of the Defd^t he did accomodate & lend unto him the defd^t a boate & Oares to fetch corne from Wickaco^moco River to his owne howse & did deli^v the sd boate to Richard Bell the Defd^{ts} Overseer to the same use, And required his said boate of the Defd^t, he hath neglected & doth refuse to deliver the sd boate unto him the Pl^t to his da^mage 2000th tobacco, The Defd^t Thomas Howell saith that the Pl^t hath no cause of ac^con agst him because the boate & Oares were not borrowed at his instance & request as averred by the Pl^t And brings his Plea of Demurrer agst the Pl^t & saith there is no certainty of tyme or thing men^coned in the declara^con & therefore is not Sufficient in Law Whereupon the Court Ordrd a Nonsuite to be entred agst the Pl^t there beinge no cause of Action & to pay Costs of suite
