In a difference dependinge betweene M^r Henry Adams Plaintiff & Michaell Ashford Defd^t, the Defd^t absentinge himselfe out of the Province, An attachment is granted to the Pl^t against any of the goods & chattells of the Defd^t wheresoever found to the value of nine thousand pounds of Tobac^o Provided the Pl^t secure the Court from any damage which shall or may accrue to them by grantinge this Attachm^t.

The Court is adjourned untill Tuesday the 18th of this pⁿte Novemb^r & all process continued.

In a difference dependinge betweene William Barton Senior Pl^t & Michaell Ashford Defd^t William Barton Junio^r declared that he heard M^r Tho: Hussey acknowledge that he was indebted to Michaell Ashford & that he would pay or see that the Pl^t should be paid his debt due to him from the Defd^t.

It is ordered that Robert Rowland be Guardian to William Hungerford sonne of William Hungerford late of this County deceased.

An attachment is granted unto Phillip Lynes agst the estate of Thomas Westcot (for that he is not to be found in the County) for th^e Sum^e of Seaven hundred & thirty pounds of Tobac^o & cost

The Court is adjourned for two howers
The Court sitts & the Com^{rs} are present ut supra

It is ordered that there be a nonsuite entred agst Nicholas Richardson Pl^t at th^e request of George Athy Defd^t for that the Pl^t appeared not agst the Defd^t this Court to implead him

In a difference dependinge betweene Francis Wyne Pl^t & Francis Kilborne defd^t, after a lunge debate it appeared to the Court the Pl^t had no cause of action & ordered nonsuite agst him
