This Indenture made the first day of August in the xxxiid yeare of the Dominion of Cecilius Lord Propryetary &c Annog Dni 1673: Between Jobe Corner of Charles County in the Province of Maryland Plant of the one pte & John Hackister of the Same County Cooper of the other pte, Witnesseth that the sd Jobe Corner for & in considaçon of the Sume of two thousand five hundred pounds of good Sound mehtable tob & caske & other valueable considera cons him hereunto moveing All wich the sd John Hackister hath allready pd & pformed to the sd Jobe Corner before the ensealeing & delivery of these p<sup>r</sup>sents the receipt and pformance whereof he the sd Jobe Corner doth hereby acknowledge and him Self therewith to be fully Satisfied contented and pd & thereof and of pt & pcell thereof doth clearely acquitt exonerate and discharge the sd John Hackister his heyres Executors and Admrs for ever by these presents Hath given granted Sold aliened enfeofeed & confirmd And by these presents doth give grant bargaine Sell enfeofee & confirm unto the sd John Hackister his heyres & assigns All that quantity or peell of Land called Jobes Comfort Scituate lyeing and being in Charles County aforesd & begining at a bounded poplar Standing neare a bounded Gumm a bound Tree of William Heards Land on the East Side of the mayne fresh of Portobacco or St Thomas Creeke bounding upon the sdd Heards land South one hundred & Sixty pehes to a bounded Spanish Oke Standing upon a plaine, Thence East two hundred piches to a bounded red oke Standing upon the sd plaine thence North one hundred & Sixty oches untill it intersects a paralell drawne from the first bound Tree containing and laid out for two hundred acres of Land be it more or less wth all and Singular its Rights Members and appurtenances Together with all houses edifices build-
