Thomas King doe give unto Owen Jones Junior one yeareling red pied Heifer, marked crop't on both Eares and a peice left in the overkeel on both eares and being the s^d Owens proper marke

and also one yeareling browne pied heifer unto Eliz^a Jones the Daughter of Owen Jones, mark't crop't & underkeeled on the left Eare & being th^e s^d Eliz^a proper marke.

Maryland ss Aprill the 22d 1674 the deposi^on of Henry Bonner aged twenty eight yeares or thereabouts came & made oath th^t about the twenty fourth day of March last past he asked Thomas Russell w^t Rich^d Ambrose was to give him for receiveing his to^b: who made answeare a thousand poundes of to^b, & then he asked me what he (th^t is the s^d Ambrose) did allow W^m Gater & I made answeare a thousand pounds of to^b: & he answeared th^t was well but Some thing wth the least and farther Sayes not, Sworne before me th^e day & yeare above written

This Indenture made the tenth day of September In the yeare of our Lord one thousand six hundred Seaventy & three And in the 42^d yeare of the Dominion of Caecilius Absolute Lord Prop^{rtary} of the Province of Maryland & Avalon Lord Baron of Baltamore & Betweene John Haggister of Charles County in the s^d Province of Maryland Cooper of th[']one p^{te} And Philip Gibbon of the s^d County Gent['] of th[']other p^{te} Witnesseth that the s^d John Haggister for & in Considera^on of the su^me of Six thousand five hundred pounds of good Sound m^{ch}^{table} Tobacco & Cask to him in hand paide before th[']ensealeinge & deli^vy of these p^{ntes} by the s^d Philip Gibbon the receipt whereof the s^d John Haggister doth acknowledge & thereof & of e^vy p^{te} & p^{cell} thereof doth clearely acquitt exonerate & discharge the s^d Philip Gibbon his heires execut^{rs} & adm^{rs} for ever by
