To the Worshipfull Co^missioners of Charles County Court th^e Peti^con of Charles Gregory Chirurgion, Humbly Shewes th^t in October last the Members of this Worshipfull Court were pleased to Send a poore distressed lame Man unto your Peti^coner being ulcerated of both his leggs the w^{ch} your Peti^coner tooke in cure and used his inten^cons and industry to cure both by externall & internall medecines applyed therefore may it please your Worships, the p^{er}son being almost cured that you would be pleased to award to your peti^coner the allow: w^{ch} is allready levied for your Peti^coner in part and your Peti^coner Shall continue his Industry to the effecting th^e cure, & attend for the remainder untill another yeare, & your peti^coner Shall ever pray &c.
