

In a cause depending between Francis Wine Plaintiff and Francis Kylborne Def^t the Plaintiff by his Attorney Sam Cressy declares ag^t the Def^t for that whereas Some tyme about the month of August Anno Dⁿⁱ 1673 at the Instance and request of the s^d Francis Kylborne th^e s^d Francis Wine did Sett up for him the s^d Francis Kylborne foure tonne of tob^o f^{ids}: In considera^on whereof the s^d Fra: Kilborne did assume on him Selfe & to the s^d Francis Wine did faythfully promise the Sum^e of foure hundred pounds of tob^o: yet Nevertheless the s^d Francis Kilborne hath not p^d the Same allthough often required to the great damage of him th^e s^d Wine, & therefore he brings his Suite :

And th^e s^d Francis Kilborne by his Attorney Jn^o Jones comes and defends the Suite, & Sayes th^t th^e s^d Wine ought not to have his ac^on ag^t th^e s^d Kilborne for that he did not assume in mann^r & forme as is wthin expre^st in th^e declara^on and putts himself upon the Countrey: And the s^d Fra: Wine likewise whereupon it was ordred that a jury Should be impane^ld whose names are here written

Whereas there was an attach^{mt} formerly granted to Jacob Peterson ag^t the Estate of Michⁿ Ashford & layd in the hands of Tobias Crayford: it is now ordred that Tobias Crayford give Securety for his appearence the next Court to prove the pay^{mt} of that tob^o w^{ch} was due to Michaell Ashford for Deborah his wife, otherwise to pay to Jacob Peterson one thousand poundes of tob^o wth costs

The attach^{mt} that was formerly granted to Henry Adams ag^t th^e Estate of Michaell Ashford for th^e Sum^e of nine thousand pounds of tob^o is now allso continued: untill the next Court
