This Indenture made th^e first day of September, In th^e three & fortieth yeare of th^e Dominion of Caecilius absolute Lord & Proprietarie of th^e Province of Maryland & Avalon Lord Baron of Baltmore &c: Between Henry Bonner of Charles County in th^e s^d Province of Maryland Gentl^m & Elizabeth his wife of th^e on parte, & John Taylor & Thomas Taylor naturall sons of th^e s^d Elizabeth of the other parte, witnesseth, That hee th^e s^d Henry Bonner & Elizabeth his wife for & in Consideraçon of their naturall love & affection, & other good Causes & Consideraçons them hereunto moveing: Have given, granted & Confirmed & by these presents doe give, grant & Confirme unto th^e s^d John Taylor & Thomas Taylor their heires & assignes for ever, All that parcell of Land formerly surveyed for John Taylor father of th^e aforemençoned John Taylor & Thomas Taylor & granted by Patent unto the abovemençoned Elizabeth Taylor as Relict of th^e s^d John Taylor (th^e father,) from th^e Right Honorable Caecilius absolute Lord & Proprietarie of Maryland afores^d under th^e great seale of th^e s^d Province of Maryland th^e on & twentieth day of August in th^e seaven & twentieth yeare of th^e Dominion of th^e s^d Caecilius over th^e s^d Province Annoq̄ Doñi (1658) witnessed by Josias Fendall Esquire then Leiftcnant of th^e s^d Province, & by him signed, Lyeing on th^e north side of a Creeke in a Potomacke River Called Petits Creeke, Begining at a markt white oake standing at a bite of th^e s^d Creeke called Taylors bite ruñing west north west from th^e s^d oake by th^e Creeke side for th^e Length of on hundred forty & foure perchas to a markt oake standing at th^e mouth of a branch called Weekes Branch bounding on th^e west with a line drawn north into the woods for th^e Length of foure hundred perchas to a marked Oake on th^e north with th^e Land of Rich^d Smith, on th^e East & south with th^e s^d Petits Creeke Conteineing foure hundred & fifty acres more or lesse: Together with all profitts Rights & benefitts thereunto belonging as by th^e
