Wee whose names are underwritten at th^e speciall instance &
 request of Hugh Thomas & Thomas Lomax Did goe & see a division
 of a tract of Land Lyeinge scituate & being above th^e head of
 Wiccomico River in Charles County in th^e Province of Maryland
 belonging unto them, made by M^r Richard Edelen Deputy Survey^r, &
 allsoe according to Lott th^e south end of th^e s^d land with a plan-
 tation thereon Erected did fall unto th^e afores^d Hugh Thomas & th^e
 north end according to Division unto the afores^d Thomas Lomax,
 with this allowance followeinge unto th^e s^d Lomax in Considera^on
 of th^e Plantation (to say) th^e s^d Hugh Thomas shall pay & allow
 th^e s^d Thomas Lomax seaventeene hundred pounds of good tobaccoe
 in Caske upon Demand & seaventeene hundred pounds more at or
 before th^e tenth day of October next ensueinge th^e date hereof,
 as allsoe th^e s^d Lomax to have th^e use & benefitt of halfe th^e plan-
 tation afores^d & halfe th^e houses thereon now erected untill th^e
 last day of October which shall be in th^e yeare of our Ld 1674,
 And whereas there is two parcells of Land leased out of th^e whole
 tract afores^d (to say) one parcell unto Meverell Hulse in Hugh
 Thomas his Lott & on parcell unto John Posie in Thomas Lomax
 his lott, the parties in whose lott each parcell falls is to pay his
 rent to th^e same & become his teñant, And wee doe hereby declare
 th^t the afores^d Hugh Thomas & Thomas Lomax was & is Contented
 & satisfied with th^e afores^d Division & upon th^e tearmes afores^d, In
 wittnesse whereof wee have hereunto sett our hand th^e 25th day
 of October Annoq̄ Doñi (1673)
