

Liber F neither to th^e s^d Nich in his life time nor to th^e s^d John to whom Admistracon of th^e goods Chattles & Creditts of th^e s^d Nich was Committed since his death hath not satisfied but doth altogether refuse to pay th^e same, whereupon th^e s^d John saith hee is damnified & hath lost to th^e value of 200th of tobaccoe & thereupon hee bringeth his suite

The Defendant Jeremiah Dickison appears in his proper person to defend th^e suite Comensed, & th^e plaintife for want of prooffe to his declaracon th^e worshipfull th^e Comissioners finds th^t there is noe Cause of action & thereupon hee obtained a non suite

In a Cause depending betweene John Allen Adm^r of th^e goods Chattles & Creditts of Nich Solby de^c plaintife & stephen Gough Defendant

Stephen Gough was Attached to Answer to John Allen Adm^r of th^e goods Chattles & Creditts of Nich Solby late of this County de^c of a plea of trespas on th^e Case

And whereupon th^e s^d John by Samuell Cressey his Attorney Complaineth against th^e s^d Stephen for th^t whereas th^e s^d Nich did on th^e 13th day of July 1673 & from th^t time untill th^e 16th day of th^e same moneth attend on him th^e s^d Stephen & administer to him th^e s^d Stephen divers parcell of Phisicke in all amounteinge to th^e sume of three hundred & seaventy pounds of tobaccoe, As by a particular account here in Court by th^e s^d John produced more plainly may appeare, In Consideracon whereof th^e s^d Stephen did then assume on himselfe & to th^e s^d Nich did faithfully promise that hee th^e s^d Stephen when thereunto required to him th^e s^d Nich th^e s^d sume of 370th of tobaccoe would well & truely pay, Yett neverthesse th^e s^d Stephen although often thereunto required th^e s^d sume of three hundred & seaventy pounds of tobaccoe neither to th^e s^d Nich in his life time nor to th^e s^d John to whom Administration of all & singular th^e goods Chattles & Creditts of th^e s^d Nich was Committed since his death hath not paid but doth altogether refuse to pay th^e same, whereupon th^e s^d John saith hee hath lost to th^e value of 500th of tobaccoe & thereupon hee bringeth his suite

And th^e s^d Stephen Gough Defendant (by John Jones his Attorney) comes & defends th^e force & injury &c And saith hee hath not received th^e Phisicke within mentioned in maⁿer & forme as within exprest &c: nor did not Assume

The plaintife wanting prooffe to his declaracon, Thereupon the worshipfull th^e Comissioners orders a nonsuite against th^e plaintife with Cost of suite
