

Liber F indebted unto him th^e s^d John Allen considerable sumes of tobaccoe, & dyeinge left an estate in th^e hands of sundry persons, who have Combined to Conceale th^e same on purpose to defraud & deceive his Creditors, whereupon th^e s^d John Allen being one of th^e Cheife Creditors was at th^e charge & did procure & obtained letters of Administracon of th^e goods & Chattles &c of him th^e s^d John Hitchinson, which letters are ready to be produced in Court, And whereas William Allen allsoe de^c, in his life time, was indebted fiftene hundred pounds of good sweet porke unto him th^e s^d John Hitchinson, and dyeinge left his widdow who administred upon his estate, whose widdow since is married unto th^e Defendant Gerrard Browne, of whom th^e plaintife John Allen hath often demanded th^e 1500th of porke who of Right ought to pay th^e same, But th^e s^d Gerrard Browne hath refused & doth refuse to pay th^e same unto th^e s^d John Allen, whereupon hee brings his suite, & saith hee is damified & hath losse to th^e value of 3000th of tobaccoe

And th^e s^d Gerrard Browne by Samuell Cressey his Attorney Comes & defends th^e force & injury when &c: & saith th^t hee th^e s^d John Allen ought not to have his action against him for that hee is barred thereof by a certaine act of Assembly made at S^t Maries Anno Do^mi 1666 entituled an Act for limitation of sundry actions for avoideing of suites at law & of this hee craves judgement.

[p. 32] Whereupon th^e Defend^t Gerrard Browne who married th^e Relict of William Allen de^c obtained a nonesuite p^r order of Court against th^e plaintife John Allen as Adm^r of all & singular th^e goods & Chattles &c of John Hitchinson de^c with cost of suite noe bill of cost entred

In a matter of difference depending betweene Richard Dod plaintife & Robert Tote Defendant

Robert Tote of Charles County Inholder was Attached to Answer to Richard Dod of th^e same County of a plea wherefore by force & armes at th^e plantation whereon th^e s^d Robert now lives at Wiccomico in th^e County afores^d one bull of th^e proper goods & Chattles of him th^e s^d Richard of th^e price of six hundred pounds of tobacco out of th^e woods did fetch & then & there did kill to th^e great damage of him th^e s^d Richard, & Contrary to th^e peace of th^e Right Hon^{bl} th^e Ld Proprietary.

And whereupon th^e s^d Richard by Samuell Cressey his Attorney Complaineth against th^e s^d Robert, for that whereas th^e s^d Robert did sometime in th^e Moneth of Septemb^r in th^e 43^d yeare of th^e Dominion of Caecilius &c over this Province Anno^q Do^mi 1674 at th^e house where th^e s^d Robert doth now live at Wiccomico in th^e County afores^d fetch up one bull of th^e proper goods & Chattles of th^e s^d Richard of th^e value of six hundred pounds of tobaccoe out of th^e woods, & th^e s^d bull then & there did kill to th^e damage of him
