In a Cause depending betweene Benjamin Rozer plaintife & John Allen Adm^r of all & singular th^e goods & Chattles of Nicholas Solby deē Defendant

John Allen Administrat^r of all & singular th^e goods & Chattles of Nicholas Solby deē was Attached to Answer unto Benjamin Rozer of a plea that hee render unto him two thousand pounds of tobacco which hee unjustly deteineth.

[p. 35] Whereupon th^e s^d Benjamin in his prop^{er} person saith, that whereas the afores^d Nicholas in his life on th^e fifth day of Novemb^r 1673 by his certaine writeing obligatory sealed with his seale, which th^e s^d Benjamin bringeth here in Court, Did acknowledge himselve to owe & stand justly indebted unto th^e s^d Benjamin th^e full & just quantity of two thousand pounds of tobacco & Caske to be paid unto th^e s^d Benjamin his heires &c at or before th^e tenth day of Octob^r then next ensueinge, And to th^e same payment well & truely to be made th^e afores^d Nicholas did binde himselve his heires Exec^{rs} & Adm^{rs} by th^e same bill Yett neither th^e afores^d Nicholas in his life time, nor th^e s^d John to whom Administracon of all & singular th^e goods & Chattles which were of th^e s^d Nicholas at th^e time of his death was Comitted although often demanded, th^e afores^d 2000^{lb} of tobacco have not rendred to th^e s^d Benjamin & th^e s^d John to render doth deny & unjustly deteine, whereupon hee
