Know all men by these presents that I Nicholas Solby of Charles County in th^e Province of Maryland Gentleman doe owe & stand justly indebted to Benj^a Rozer of th^e same Province Merch^t th^e full & just quantity of two thousand pounds of good sound bright & large leafe tobacco in Caske to be paid unto th^e s^d Benjamin Rozer his heires Exec^{rs} Adm^{rs} or Assignes at or before th^e tenth day of Octob^r next ensueinge th^e date hereof Conveniently by th^e waterside neare Portobacco Creeke, To th^e which paym^t well & truly to be made I binde my selfe my heires Exec^{rs} & Adm^{rs} firmly by these presents Wittnesse my hand & seale this fifth day of Novemb^r 1673

Whereupon th^e worshipfull th^e Court orders a judgement upon th^e s^d bill for two thousand pounds of tobaccoe, to be paid by th^e s^d John Allen Adm^r of all & singular th^e goods & Chattles of Nicho: Solby de^c Defendant, to th^e s^d Benjamin Rozer plaintife out of the estate of th^e said Nicholas Solby deceased.

In a Cause depending betweene William Ward plaintife & Richard Clowter Defendant.

Richard Clowter of Portobacco Carpenter was Attached to Answer unto William Ward of a plea that hee render unto him th^e sume of Eight hundred Eighty three pounds of tobacco which to him hee oweth & unjustly deteineth.

And whereupon th^e s^d William by Saⁿ Cressey his Attorney Complaineth against th^e s^d Richard, for that whereas th^e s^d Richard by his Certaine writeing obligatory, sealed with the seale of him th^e s^d Richard whose date is th^e 3^d day of June Anno Do^mi 1674 Did acknowledge himselfe to owe & stand indebted to him th^e s^d William in th^e s^d sume of Eight hundred Eighty three pounds of tobacco to be paid Conveniently in Charles County afores^d upon demand as by th^e s^d Writeing here in Court produced more plainly may appeare, yett neverthelesse th^e s^d Richard although often thereunto required the s^d sume of 883^{lb} of tobacco hath not satisfied but doth altogether refuse to pay th^e same, Whereupon th^e s^d William saith hee is damnified & hath lost to th^e value of twelve hundred pounds of tobacco & thereupon hee bringeth his suite.

And th^e s^d Richard Clowter by John Jones his Attorney saith that before th^e perfecting & delivery of th^e within mentioned bills th^e s^d William Ward did promise & Assume to deliver unto th^e s^d Clowter severall bills which were out in th^e hands of sundry persons by
