Whereupon th^e Plaintife in Confirmacon of his said Declaracon [p. 217]
produceth the said Bond, and Award w^{ch} were as followeth (viz^t)

Knowe all Men by these presents That I John Lumbrozo doe
hereby Bind my selfe, my heires, Executors, Administrators, or
Assignes to pay or Cause to be paid unto Thomas Alcocks his heires,
Executors, Administrators, or Assignes the full and just Sume of
tenne thousand pounds of tobaccoe, and Caske upon all Demand

The Condicon of this obligacon is such th^t if in Case th^e said
Lumbrozo stand to th^e award of William Calvert Esq and Zachery
Wade gent concerning a difference for th^e s^d Lumbrozo's having in
his Custody severall of the s^d Alcocks goods taken out of his house
when the said Alcocks wife, and Child was Murdered by the In-
dians then the obligacon is void and of noe effect, otherwise to
stand in full force, and virtue As witnesse this my hand th^e 16th
of Novemb^r 1665.

them, and have each to the other bound themselves in a Bond of

to stand to our Award Nowe Knowe ye th^t wee doe Award That
th^e said John Lumbrozo shall pay unto the said Thomas Alcocks
the Sume of Nine hundred pounds of tobaccoe, and Caske upon
demand, and all such goods as he Received of the Indians apper-
taining to th^e English he is to Deliver to th^e said Thomas Alcocks
upon oath and this is our Award Witnesse our hands this 16th of
November 1665

It is Therefore ordered That th^e s^d John Robinson as Administra-

Alcocks th^e s^d sume of 900th of tobaccoe.
