Be it Enacted That the said Mary Philpot shall before such Sale or Sales give Bond with sufficient Sureties to the Deputy Commissary of Baltimore County for the Time being in the same Manner and Form as is Usual in Cases of Intestates Estates (which said Bond shall be by him transmitted to and lodged in the Prerogative Office) with Condition to the same That the said Mary Philpot shall dispose of account for the Monies arising by such Sale or Sales produce a Certificate from the said Deputy Commissary of such Security having been given And also that the said Mary Philpot shall within twelve Months after any Vendue as aforesaid account with the Commissary for the Produce of such Sale in the same Manner as if the same was properly personal Estate to be paid according to Law and the Meaning and Intention of this Act
