N:º 25: An Act for the Relief of the Reverend John M<sup>c</sup>Pherson of Charles County

[A Private Act]

Whereas the said John M<sup>c</sup>Pherson by his humble Petition to this present General Assembly hath set forth That for several Months past he had been a languishing Prisoner in said County Goal for larger sums than he was unfortunately able to pay That he had offered to give up his whole Estate real and personal and his future Income as Rector of William and Mary Parish in said County to and for the Benefit of his Creditors reserving only such sum out of his thirty per Poll as might be sufficient for his Support and Maintainance And the Allegations of the said Petition appearing to be true and that his lying in Goal can be of no Advantage to his Creditors it is therefore prayed that it may be Enacted

And be it Enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordships Governor and the upper and lower Houses of Assembly and the Authority of the same That Mess.<sup>rs</sup> Josias Hawkins, George Dent and Samuel Love shall and are hereby nominated constituted and appointed Trustees for the Creditors of the said John Macpherson and that from and after the first Day of July next the whole Estate real and
