The House Resolved that the said Joseph Galloway hath not complied with his Duty as Sherriff and that he be Acquainted therewith by the Speaker with a Caution to be more careful in Discharge of his Duty in relation to the Prisoners and Public Goal for the future and that he be Discharged from further Attendance on Payment of such fees as have arisen due to the Officers of this House and the said J. Galloway Attending at the Bar of this House M.^r Speaker Acquainted him accordingly
