An Ingrossed Bill Entituled an Act directing a Copy of the last Will and Testament of Col.<sup>o</sup> Henry Bouquet to be Recorded in the Prerogative Office of this Province and for other Purposes therein mentioned

An Ingrossed Bill Entituled an Act for the Tryal of All matters of fact in the several Countys where they have arisen or shall arise And an Ingrossed Bill Entituled a Supplementary Act to an Act Entituled an Act for the Speedy Tryal of all Criminals and Ascertain- ing their Punishment in the County Courts when Prosecuted there and for Payment of fees due from Criminal Persons

Were Severally Read and Assented to and sent to the Upper House with the Paper Bills thereof by M.<sup>r</sup> Wright and M.<sup>r</sup> J: Adams
