

Liber H. S. No. 1 be ended and determined before the end of the said Court Shall be and are by this Act continued until the third Tuesday in October next and that all Writs Process and Precepts already Issued or to be issued out of the Provincial Court returnable to the Second Tuesday of September Shall be returnable to the said Third Tuesday in October and that all Sheriffs Coroners and other Officers that have Arrested or Shall arrest any Person or Persons by Virtue of any Writ or Process returnable to the Second Tuesday of September Shall be under the same Obligation to have the Party arrested at Annapolis the third Tuesday in October and that all Bail Bonds taken by any Sheriff or Coroner for the Appearance of any Person or Persons at the Second Tuesday in September next Shall be taken to all Intents Constructions and Purposes Whatever and be of the same Force and Effect as if the said Bail Bonds had been or Shall be taken for the appearance of such Person or Persons at the said third Tuesday in October next any thing to the Contrary hereof notwithstanding

And Whereas Since the Commencement of April Term aforesaid Sundry Persons have been Committed for Crimes and Misdemeanours by them done and Witnesses have been bound over to Testify against Such Persons at next Provincial Court Be it therefore Enacted that all Such Commitments and Recognizances returnable before the said Provincial Court Shall be Obligated to be returned by the respective Magistrates taking Such Recognizances before the Judges of Assize in the respective Counties Where the Offences have been Committed and the Offenders and Witnesses be Obligated to Appear by Virtue of Said Recognizances accordingly This Act to Continue for Three Years and unto the End of the next Session of Assembly Which Shall happen after the Expiration of the said three years
