It was moved that as the Circumstances of the Province would Votes and require a further Emission of Bills of Credit to be lent out upon Loan, a Sum arising out of the Interest thereof might be appropriated House to that Purpose; and it was thereupon resolved, that Bills of Credit printed by to the Amount of 346,6662 Dollars be struck, and that 266,6662 Dec. 4 Dollars thereof be circulated by Way of Loan upon real and personal Security. It was then moved to be resolved, that 42,6663 Dollars, out of the Interest arising from the Loan of the said Bills of Credit be appropriated for the Establishment of a Seminary of Learning p. 60 in this Province, and the Question being put that the same be entered as the Resolve of this House, it was carried in the Affirmative.
