Arrested his Sloope w<sup>ch</sup> he Confessed he Traded in for y<sup>e</sup> said  
 skynns & severall times went out of this Province with his said  
 Sloope without making Entry of what Exported Tho Jones.

The humble petition of Richard Ackworth of Som<sup>r</sup>set County  
 planter. Humbly showeth.

That whereas Capt Thomas Jones of this County of Som<sup>r</sup>set  
 about the beginning of August in the 41<sup>th</sup> yeare of the Dominion  
 of the Right hono:<sup>ble</sup> Caecilius &c over this Province of Maryland  
 Annoque Domini 1672 made his Repayer to yo<sup>r</sup> pet<sup>rs</sup> house (in yo<sup>r</sup>  
 pet<sup>rs</sup> absence) with some others in his Company, and the said  
 Thomas Jones desired yo<sup>r</sup> Pet<sup>rs</sup> wife to let him have some syder w<sup>ch</sup>  
 yo<sup>r</sup> pet<sup>rs</sup> wife did accordingly, the said Jones Remaining from the time  
 he came w<sup>ch</sup> was about Tenn a clock in y<sup>e</sup> morning of the day he  
 came untill Early the next morning at w<sup>ch</sup> time the said Jones got  
 up not making any that did belong to my family Acquainted, Then  
 & there did illegally Ransack seize take & Carry away forty Three  
 Drest deare skynns, One hundred Eighty odd muskrat skynns,  
 Twenty ould Racoone Match coates and two beare skynns and them  
 put on board yo<sup>r</sup> pet<sup>rs</sup> Sloope, the w<sup>ch</sup> sloope he also made seizure of,  
 and both the goods aforesayd with the Sloope carryed away to the  
 Landing of M<sup>r</sup> Randall Revell, and there brake up y<sup>e</sup> Cabbin Dore  
 of yo<sup>r</sup> pet<sup>rs</sup> Sloope which was fast locked, and tooke out of y<sup>e</sup> said  
 Cabbin a pcell of shot the said Jones not giving an accompt to any  
 of my family wherefore he made seizure of the foregoing skynns  
 nor Sloope, Yo<sup>r</sup> pet<sup>rs</sup> Sloope being at his owne landing & his wife
