To all men to whome these presents shall come. I Philip Land of S<sup>t</sup> Maries, in y<sup>e</sup> Prouince of Maryland send greeting in Our Lord God Euerlasting. Know yee y<sup>t</sup> whereas there was a Plantaōn belonging to the Estate of John Wheatlie sould to me y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Philip Land by the Executo<sup>rs</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> John Wheatlie, for y<sup>e</sup> summe of fifteene hundred weight of Tob. ffor y<sup>e</sup> true paym<sup>t</sup> whereof I y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Philip Land did bind ouer One seruant named Anthony Crowder as Security. And whereas y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Tob is yett unpayd for w<sup>ch</sup> y<sup>e</sup> sd Anthony Crowder stood bownd as afores<sup>d</sup>. And whereas M<sup>r</sup> Richard Wilan one of y<sup>e</sup> Executo<sup>rs</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> John Wheatlie hath declared himselfe willing to take the sayd Land againe for y<sup>e</sup> use of y<sup>e</sup> Orphans of y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Wheatlie, & to discharge me y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Philip from y<sup>e</sup> sd fueteene hund<sup>d</sup> pownds of Tob. in case I would bind ouer the s<sup>d</sup> Anthony Crowder as security for y<sup>e</sup> paym<sup>t</sup> of Seauen hund<sup>d</sup> pownds of Tob to y<sup>e</sup> Executo<sup>rs</sup> aforesd. W<sup>ch</sup> s<sup>d</sup> seauen hund<sup>d</sup> pownds of Tob I y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Philip receaued for y<sup>e</sup> Rent of y<sup>e</sup> aforesd Plantaōn during y<sup>e</sup> time it was in y<sup>e</sup> poses<sup>n</sup> of me y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Philip. Now Know yee y<sup>t</sup> I y<sup>e</sup> sd Philip Land doe hereby assigne back all my Right & tittle to y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Plantaōn afores<sup>d</sup>, unto y<sup>e</sup> Executo<sup>rs</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Wheatlie, & doe allso by these presents firmly bind ouer y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Anthony Crowder as security for y<sup>e</sup> true paym<sup>t</sup> of ye s<sup>d</sup> Seauen hund<sup>d</sup> pownds of Tob. soe receaued as aforesd. In wittnes whereof I y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Philip Land haue hereunto sett my hand y<sup>e</sup> Sixteenth day of Nouemb<sup>r</sup> 1659
