To all to whom these p<sup>r</sup>nts shall come. Wee George Beckwith of Caluert County in the Province of Maryland Plant<sup>r</sup> & ffrancis his Wife y<sup>e</sup> late Daughter of Nicholas Haruey of y<sup>e</sup> Prouince afores<sup>d</sup> deceased send Greeting. Know yee y<sup>t</sup> wee y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> George & ffrancis Beckwith for a ualuable consideracõn to us allready payd haue gyuen, graunted, bargained, sold, assigned, & sett ouer. And by these p<sup>r</sup>nts doe for us & eyther [of u]s our or eyther of Our heyres, fully, freely, & absolutely . . . bargaine sell [assigne & sett] ouer unto Emperour Smith, and Abdolo Martin, of y<sup>e</sup> County & Prouince aboues<sup>d</sup>, all our right, title, interest, claime & demand whatsoever of in & to one parcell of Land, scituate, lying & being on y<sup>e</sup> South side of Patuxt Riuer by y<sup>e</sup> back Creeke, being surueyed & layd out for One hund<sup>d</sup> sixty fiue Acres more or lesse. To haue & to hold y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Land w<sup>th</sup> all Timber trees, & all other rights members priuiledges, & apurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging unto y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Empero<sup>r</sup> Smith & Abdolo Martin, their & eyther of their heyres for euer. With warranty ag<sup>st</sup> us y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> George and ffrancis Beckwith our, & eyther of Our heyres, or any other persons y<sup>t</sup> shall or may by from, or under us, or eyther of us or any other way whatsoever claime any right, tittle, or interest thereunto. In wittnes whereof Wee haue hereunto sett our hands, & affixed our Seales this 8<sup>th</sup> of ffebruary Anõ Dm̄ 1658.
