And whereupon the said Thomas Thropp by John Jones his Attorny Saith that whereas Gervais Barty Edward Man & Thomas Spaight by their certaine writeing Obligatory under their hands & Seales dated the sevententh day of April 1676 did acknowledge themselves to be holden & firmly bound unto the said Thomas Thropp in the full & just Summe of One hundred forty five pounds Sterling to be paid to the said Thomas Thropp his executors or lawfull Attorny upon demand to the which payment well & truly to be made a done they did bind themselves their heirs executrs a administrators joyntly & Severally as by the said writeing here ready to be produced in Court it doth & may more at large appeare.
