And whereupon the said Marke Cordea by Robert Ridgely his Attorney complaineth, that whereas the said Peter Mills the tenth day of April in the second yeare of the Dominion of Charles &c Annoq̄ Doni 1677. by force & armes one brown bay mare of about five yeares old of the price of three thousand p^{ds} of tobacco, & one Stone Colt of about a yeare old of the price of one thousand p^{ds} of tobacco of the proper Goods & Chattels of the said Marke Cordea att Newtown in the County aforesaid lately found he the said Peter did take away, & the said Mare by rideing & other worke did so over labour that att the plantacon of the said Peter aforesaid by his over rideing & over working her she the said Mare dyed, & the said Peter the said Colt detained in his Plantacon aforesaid And the said Colt to certaine persons unknown did sell to the great damage of the said Marke Cordea & ag^t the peace of the right Hon^{ble} the Lord Prop^{ty} that now is whereupon the said Marke saith he hath losse & is worse
