Allowed unto Giles Collyer of S<sup>t</sup> Maryes County for comeing goeing & attendance to testifie for Mary Pope ag<sup>t</sup> Philip Lynes two hundred & Seventy pounds of tobacco

Allowed unto Margaret Catterton of Calvert County for comeing goeing & attendance to testifie for Tho: Hagelton a Negro ag<sup>t</sup> Tho: Truman two hundred & Seventy pounds of tobacco

June 5<sup>th</sup> 1679

Ordered by the Court, that Execution issue forth upon the judgem<sup>t</sup> obtained by the right Hon<sup>ble</sup> Charles Lord Baltmore against Arthur Carleton Adm<sup>r</sup> of the Goods & Chattles of Thomas Carleton deceased, Charles James & Tho: Todd Exec<sup>r</sup> of the last Will & testam<sup>t</sup> of Thomas Todd deceased upon the forfeiture of the bond of Administracōn & against every one of them.

Robert Ridgely one of the Attorneys of this Court acknowledged satisfaction to two judgm<sup>ts</sup> obtained by him against Arthur Carleton Adm<sup>r</sup> of the Goods & Chattles of Thomas Carleton deceased, one for foure hundred pounds of tobacco damāges & the other for twelve pounds sterll debt together with three pounds twelve shillings sterf damāges with costs of suite
