And whereupon the said Thomas by Robert Carvile his Attorney saith, that whereas the said Richard upon the day of in the yeare One thousand six hundred Seventy six by his certaine Obligacōn Sealed with the Seale of him the said Richard & here in Court produced whose date is the day & yeare abovesaid, did confesse & acknowledge himselfe to owe & stand indebted to the said Thomas in the sume of five thousand two hundred pounds of good sound M^r chantable tobacco with cask to be paid upon his own plantacōn att or before the tenth day of October then next Yet the said Richard the said Sume of five thousand two hundred pounds of tobacco to him the said Thomas though often thereunto requested hath not paid, but the same to pay hath hitherto denyed & refused
