And whereupon the same John Addison by Robert Ridgely his Attorney saith, that whereas he the said John Addison att the speciall instance & request of the said Marke Cordea & for the true debt of the same Marke Cordea, the Eighteenth day of June in the yeare of our Lord One thousand Six hundred seventy & Eight, att the City of S^t Maryes by his certaine writing obligatory became bound to the same Charles Lord Baltimore together with the same Marke Cordea & Walter Hall deceased in the same twenty one thousand seven hundred twenty & two pounds of tobacco, with a Condition to the same writing obligatory subscribed for the true paym^t of the sume of tenn thousand Eight hundred sixty & one pounds of tobacco upon the tenth day of Decemb^r then next ensuing, att which said tenth day of Decemb^r the said Charles Lord Baltimore att the City of S^t Maryes aforesaid requested the same Marke Cordea as principall debtor to pay to the same Charles Lord Baltimore the said tenn thousand Eight hundred Sixty & one pounds of tobacco And the said Marke the same to the said Charles Lord Baltimore to pay then & there altogether refused And the same tenn thousand Eight hundred Sixty & one pounds of tobacco to the said Charles Lord Baltimore att that day paid not, whereupon the said Charles Lord
