itteth here into Court his certaine bill against Robert Carvile gentl one of the Attorneys of this Court of a plea that he render unto him the full & just Sume of One thousand seven hundred twenty & nine pounds of tobacco which to him he oweth & unjustly detaineth

And whereupon the said Gilbert by Robert Ridgely his Attorney saith, that, whereas the said Robert Carvile The third day of July p. 49 One thousand six hundred Seventy Eight, by his certaine bill obligatory sealed with the Seale of him the said Robert Carvile & here in Court produc[d] whose date is the day & yeare aforesaid, did binde himselfe his heyres Exrs & Admrs to pay or cause to be paid to the said Gilbert his heyres Exrs Admrs or assignes the full & just Sume of One thousand seven hundred twenty & nine pounds of tobacco att or upon the tenth day of Octobr next in some convenient place in St Maryes County, notwithstanding which the said Robert Carvile the said One thousand seven hundred twenty & nine pounds of tobacco to him the said Gilbert although often thereunto required according to the tenour of the said bill obligatory hath not paid but the same to pay hath denyed & as yet doth deny, whereupon the said Gilbert saith he is damnified & hath losse to the Value of three thousand pds of tobacco & thereupon he bringeth his suite.
