

p. 649 And Whereupon Thomas Burford who for the said Lord Prop^{ty} in this behalfe prosecuteth for the said Lord Prop^{ty} sayth that Whereas the said William the Twentyeth day of March in the yeare of Our Lord One thousand Six hundred Eighty and two at the City of St Maries in st Maries County did accompt with the said Lord Prop^{ty} of divers sumes of Tobacco by the said William to the said Lord Prop^{ty} before that time due and unpayd, Upon w^{ch} account the said William was found in arrears to the said Lord Proprietary in the said Two hundred thousand pounds of tobacco to be payd unto the said Lord Proprietary when he the said William should be thereto required, Nevertheles the said William Although often required the said Two hundred thousand Pounds of tobacco to the said Lord Prop^{ty} hath not Rendered but hath hitherto denyed and doth still deny Whereupon the said Thomas Burford who as aforesaid for the said Lord Prop^{ty} in this behalfe prosecuteth Sayth that the said Lord Proprietary is the worse & hath damage to the vallue of Twenty thousand pounds of Tobacco. And this for the said Lord Prop^{ty} he is ready to verify &c^a
