Richard Walker appointed Inspector Bladensburgh Warehouse in Prince George's County in the room of Abraham Boyd resigned.

William Bowie 3d. appointed Inspector of Upper Marlbro Warehouse in Prince George's County in the room of Benjamin Benjamin Brookes, deceased.
