A Petition from Ann Tilly of Anne Arundel County, accompanied by a Certificate from the Clerk of the Court, was laid before the Board, setting forth that at August Court 1786, She was fined twelve hundred pounds of Tobacco on two Presentments for selling Liquor without Licence, that she is a Person whose indigent circumstances render her unable to pay the said fine, and three of the Justices of the County Court aforesaid having Recommended the Petitioner for relief, The Board upon Consideration of her Case, do order and direct the said fine to be remitted.
