That the said Treasurer pay to James Gille's Adm'r. Eighteen pounds fifteen shillings, Jonathan Short's Adm'r. Fifteen pounds, twelve shillings and six pence and also to William Crookshanks Admx Fifteen pounds, twelve shillings and six pence due for five Months pay as Trumpeter and Troopers in Lees Legion from 1st. August 1780 to 1st. January 1781 per Certificates of Auditor General.

That the said Treasurer pay to Jub Fowler Three pounds Current Money per Account passed by the Deputy Auditor.
