That the said Treasurer pay to John Shaw fourteen pounds, three shillings and fourpence current money to be by him expended in Transporting the Military Stores from this City to Frederick Town and accounted for.

Copy of the Signals between the Emperor of Morocco and the United States, granted James Wallace Captain of the Ship *Sally*, seventy five feet Keel, of the burthen of two hundred and ninety seven Tons, and Registered at Annapolis on the 26th. of April 1786, the property of John Muir, Charles Wallace and Joshua Johnson of Maryland merchants, having been formerly Registered at the Port of Chester.
