That the said Treasurer pay to Mrs. Ann Levascher widow of Lieut. John Levascher fifteen pounds for one quarter's half pay due the 1st. instant,

That the said Treasurer pay to Robert Goldsborough Esquire Two hundred and fifty pounds for half a year's Salary as one of the Judges of the General Court due the 1st instant,

That the said Treasurer pay to Alexander Contee Hanson Esqr. one hundred and twenty five pounds for one quarter's Salary as one of the Judges of the General Court, ending the 1st. instant.
