That the said Treasurer pay to William Farris thirteen pounds one shilling and nine pence due him for keeping in repair the State Clocks at the Government House per Account passed by the Auditor General.

Saturday 29th. November 1788

The Council met.

Ordered that the Western Shore Treasurer pay to Mrs. Ann Levascher Widow of Lieut. John Levascher fifteen pounds for three months half pay due the 1st. instant.
