And another fine of five pounds on the said Ring and one pound ten shillings on Smith for having assaulted and beat the aforesaid Dugan. The Petitioners set forth that they are so poor as to be entirely unable to pay the whole of the said fines, and the Board being well certified of the poverty of the Petitioners do in consideration thereof Order that of the said Thomas Ring's fines amounting to ten pounds, the sum of five be remitted, and that of the fines imposed on Elias Smith amounting to three pounds the sum of One pound, ten shillings be remitted.
