Agreeably to a Resolve of the General Assembly for competing the records of the Chancery Office, the Board have contracted with Mr. Samuel Harvey Howard Register in Chancery to transcribe and record in a proper manner and in good books, to be procured at his own Expence the Proceedings of the Court of Chancery from the year 1773 to December in the year 1786 at the rate of seven pounds of Tobacco per side.
