Whereas it appears by a Certificate from Richard Moale Clerk to the Commissioners for Baltimore Town, that the said Commissioners have not appointed an Inspector of Salt Provisions for the said Town of Baltimore for the present year. We in pursuance of the power vested in us by Law Do appoint Major Nathaniel Smith Inspector of Salt Provisions for the said Town of Baltimore, to hold the said Office until an Appointment is made by the said Commissioners agreeably to Law.
