Henry Hollingsworth Esqr., who was appointed an Agent for the purchase and Sale of property taken in Execution on behalf of the State, for Cæcil, Kent and Queen Anns Counties, having transmitted a Bond executed by himself with Samuel Gilpin Security, the same is approved of and ordered to be filed.
